



Important Terms & Conditions - About Fees

- i. Admission Fees or Provisional Admission Fees/Enrollment Fees - is non-refundable once admission/enrollment is done.
- ii. In case, school cancels admission on any grounds, school will refund the Admission/Provisional Admission Fees/ Enrollment Fees by deducting a specific charge as mentioned in the Terms & Condition Document.
- iii. School fees has to be paid on time as per installment/quarter plan.
- iv. School Fees will only be collected via our ODMConnect App. No other payment mode such as Cash/Cheque/QR Code/DD/RTGS or NEFT will be accepted.
