THIS SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF TRUST IS MADE at RANCHI on this the 11 day of May 2011.

BETWEEN

ROHIT SAHU aged 38 years, son of Late Kishore Sahu, by occupation business and Social Worker, resident of "Sushila Niketan". Radium Road, P.S. Kotwali, District Ranchi hereinafter called "THE SETTLOR" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or contrary to the meaning thereof, include his heirs, executors, legal representatives, administrator and assigns) of the ONE PART. Indian Citizen.

1. **MOHITA SAHU**, aged 33 years, daughter of Sri Pramod Jaiswal, by occupation Social Worker, resident of "Sushila Niketan", Radium Road, P. S. Kotwali, District Ranchi. Indian Citizen
2. **SMT. MANU SAHU**, age 58 years, wife of Late Kishore Sahu, by occupation Housewife, resident of "Sushila Niketan", Radium Road, P. S. Kotwali, District Ranchi. Indian Citizen.

Hereinafter jointly called and referred to as "THE TRUSTEES" (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or contrary to the meaning thereof include the survivor or survivors and/or their successors-in-office, as the case may be) of the OTHER PART.


WHEREAS by a registered Deed of Trust being No. IV 1021 dated 21.07.2005 Rohit Sahu the SETTLOR and 1. Mohita Sahu, 2. Smt. Manu Sah, 3. Pramod Jaiswal and 4. Anita Jaiswal as TRUSTEES, created a trust known as "Kishore Sahu Memorial Education & Charitable Trust" (hereinafter referred to as "The Said Trust")

AND WHEREAS that the Trustee Mr. Pramod Jaiswal and Mrs. Anita Jaiswal has shown their wish to resign from the board of trustees and the other trustee have accepted their resignation and then this supplementary trust deed is being constituted now in board of trustees will comprise of 1. Rohit Sahu, 2. Mohita Sahu and 3. Smt. Manu Sahu.


Now this trust shall constitute of the following Trustees :-

1. **MOHITA SAHU**, aged 28 years, daughter of Sri Pramod Jaiswal, by occupation Social Worker, resident of "Sushila Niketan", Radium Road, P. S. Kotwali, District Ranchi. Indian Citizen
2. **SMT. MANU SAHU**, age 52 years, wife of Late Kishore Sahu, by occupation Housewife, resident of "Sushila Niketan", Radium Road, P. S. Kotwali, District Ranchi. Indian Citizen.

- (1) This TRUST shall continue to be called "KISHORE SAHU MEMORIAL EDUCATIONAL & CHARITABLE TRUST", Ranchi, with its Registered Office for the present situated at 12 Milestone, Ranchi Khunti Road, Hardag, Ranchi 835321.
- (2) This Office may, however, be shifted to such other place or places as the TRUSTEES may, as and when, deem it necessary.
- (3) The property of the TRUST will include :
 - A. Such contributions and donations, endowments as may be made by the public, institutions and the like for the purpose of advancing the implementation of the objects and purposes of this TRUST, and
 - B. Such acquisitions and additions that may be made by the TRUSTEES.
- (4) Objects of the TRUST shall be:-
 - (a) To start Educational Institutions for imparting formal and non-formal education to the public in general and to the rural masses and people residing in underdeveloped areas in particular.
 - (b) To establish and run hostels for 'students to promote, conduct or patronise all activities of educational character for the benefit and utility of the general public, especially of the under privileged class of society.
 - (c) TO establish, run, support and grant aid or other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institutions of like nature at such place or places as the TRUSTEES may deem III and proper.
 - (d) To establish, maintain and run studentship, scholarships, and render other kind Of aid to students including supply of books, stipends, medals and other incentives to study.




- (e) To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts for the preservation of Indian culture, the historical monuments and for the research in above subjects, establish institutions.
- (f) To organise cultural programmes, annual sports, seminars and debates, essay writing competition, painting competitions, tours and travels AND for the said purpose invite artists, eminent sportsmen, eminent educationists, speakers, students of all schools in the State of Jharkhand and across India to participate in such programmes.
- (g) To undertake programmes and projects for advancing the economic, social and cultural interests of the society at large and in particular the weaker sections of the society.
- (h) To undertake projects of Rural Development.
- (i) To establish, develop, maintain and grant aid in cash or kind to Hospitals, Medical Schools, Medical Colleges, Nursing Institutions, Dispensaries, Maternity Homes, Child Welfare Centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions for the benefit of the public in general and tribals in particular.
- (j) To render medical help to the public by starting Charitable Dispensaries, Hospitals, Health Centers etc.
- (k) To impart Health Education to the rural masses and people residing in underdeveloped area.
- (l) To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during Natural Calamities like, Famine, Earthquake, Flood, Fire, Tempest, Civil Commotion, Pestilence, etc. and to give donations and other assistance to institutions, voluntary organisations and other institutions or persons engaged in such relief works.
- (p) To support and render financial assistance to Charitable and Educational causes and Institutions, Trusts or Societies which



in the opinion of the TRUSTEES would carry out all or any objects of the TRUST, for means of donations, grants on such terms and conditions as the TRUSTEES deem fit and proper.

- (q) To award Scholarships to students and such other individuals who have devoted themselves to the various public causes in line with the objects of the TRUST.
- (r) To do all such things as the TRUSTEES find necessary for the attainment of the attainment of the above objects AS THE TRUSTEES may think fit PROVIDED that the income as well as the capital and also the corpus shall be applied only towards the public Charitable Purposes aforesaid and any accumulation of income shall also be deemed to be made for application to such charitable purposes aforesaid.
- (5) The TRUSTEES shall stand possessed of the said sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) only in cash, and also the Profits And Income thereof and Stock, Fund, Securities, Donations, Contributions, Subscriptions and Amalgamations that may hereafter be collected by the TRUSTEES under these presents and the properties movable and immovable that might be acquired in due course and for the time being representing the same respectively (hereinafter for brevity's sake called " The Trust Funds") UPON THE TRUST and with and subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter declared and contained of and concerning the same, that is to say:
 - (a) The TRUSTEES shall hold the Trust Funds UPON TRUST (so that as far as practicable the corpus shall always remain intact and only the income thereof shall be used, but with liberty to the TRUSTEES at their discretion to use the corpus from time to time either wholly or in part or parts) for the Public Charitable purposes.



- (b) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (a) of this clause, the TRUSTEES shall hold the Trust Fund UPON TRUST (so that as far as practicable the corpus shall, as far as possible, always remain intact and only the income thereof shall be used, but with liberty to the TRUSTEES at their discretion to use the corpus from time to time either wholly or in part or parts) for the fulfillment of the aims and objects of the TRUST including:
- i. Advancement of Education;
 - ii. Relief to the poor;
 - iii. Medical Relief;
 - iv. Advancement of any other object of General Public Utility as the TRUSTEES may think fit and proper;

PROVIDED FURTHER:

- (a) That notwithstanding anything hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, the income as also the corpus of the Trust Funds shall be applied and be applicable only for such Public Charitable purposes and objects and subject to such conditions or limitations, if any, as may, from time to time be laid down in the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any other replacement or re-enactment thereof or modification thereof or under any other Government taxation for the time being in force in India.
- (b) And further so that the TRUST hereby established shall be one to which the provisions of Section 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961, or any replacement, re-enactment or the modification thereof for the time being shall apply so that any donation thereto be recognised eligible for exemption or relief from tax in regard to the Donor.
- (c) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing objects or purposes but subject as aforesaid IT IS DECLARED that the TRUSTEES shall in each year apply the income of the Trust Fund, If such amount is available, in or towards any one or

more of the following objects or purposes, as the TRUSTEES may at their sole discretion think proper, that is to say :

- I. To establish, erect, equip and maintain Colleges, Schools, Libraries, free Reading Rooms, Gymnasiums, Swimming Pools, Hospitals, Dispensaries, Medical Clinics, Orphanages, Homes for old and infirm, Destitute, widows etc.
 - II. Educational Institutions encouraging Literature, Arts, Medicines, Science, Agricultural Crafts, History, Technology, Agricultural Technology and technical education in all branches.
 - III. Awarding scholarships and fellowships and stipends, and
 - IV. To pay Tuition Fees, Examination Fees, Boarding and Lodging Fees to deserving students and to supply books free of costs to such students.
- (6) This shall be an Educational and Charitable Trust and the benefits of this Trust shall enure to the public without distinction of caste, creed, religion etc.
 - (7) The TRUST created by the SETTLOR is not and shall not be revocable.
 - (8) The funds and income of the TRUST shall be solely utilised towards the achievement of the objects and no portion of it shall be utilised for payment to TRUSTEES by way of profit, interest, dividends etc.
 - (9) The TRUSTEES shall keep the moveable and immovable properties from time to time forming part of the TRUST FUND in good repair and duly insured.
 - (10) The TRUSTEES shall at all times be entitled to acquire/purchase any property for such consideration and upon such terms as the TRUSTEES, in their sole discretion, may deem fit and proper.

(11) The management of the TRUST shall continue to vest in the Board of Trustees comprising following persons

(12) The Board of Trustees shall have powers to co-opt more persons as TRUSTEES as and when it is deemed necessary, however, the total number of TRUSTEES shall not exceed 11 (Eleven).

(13) Only an Indian National residing in India can be TRUSTEE and if any TRUSTEE leaves India, permanently, he shall have to vacate his office. However this clause can be changed if Trustees desire by a vote of majority as designated under the laws to pass any new resolution.


(14) A TRUSTEE shall cease to hold the office :

- (a) On his/her death,
- (b) By giving six month's notice of his intention to resign.
- (c) On his/her becoming insane,
- (d) On his/her becoming insolvent
- (e) On his/her being expelled by the Board of Trustees for his/her acting or having acted against the interests of the TRUST by a $\frac{3}{4}$ th majority vote of the Board of (11) eleven TRUSTEES, provided such Trustee has been given a reasonable opportunity of explaining his/her conduct to the Board of Trustees.

(15) The SETTLOR shall, during his lifetime, be the ex-officio President of the TRUST and after him the Board of Trustees shall elect one among themselves as the President. The Board of Trustees shall also determine the powers, duties, responsibilities and other terms and conditions connected




- (b) To receive any money or other assets in any shape or form as gift or donation and to hold the same as capital fund and/or apply it for furthering the objects.
- (c) To invest the funds from time to time in such manner as may be decided upon by the TRUSTEES from time to time, to dispose of, alter or vary the investments from time to time, to realise the investments in conformity
- (d) To compromise, compound, abandon, submit to arbitration or otherwise institute any actions, suits proceedings, claims or other things, whatsoever, arising out of the administrators of the Trust Fund and to enter into, execute and do such agreement, instruments and composition or arrangements, releases and other things as may seem expedient, without being liable or responsible for any loss occasioned by any act or thing so done by them in good faith.
- (e) To acquire or to dispose off through mortgage, hire, lease otherwise movable or immovable, tangible or intangible properties, and rights and benefits and to manage the same.
- (f) To receive, collect or realise or cause collection or realisation of all income that accrue or become due on all or any investments and to grant receipts and discharges.
- (g) To represent the Trust in all courts original and appellate or before judicial or quasi-judicial authorities and other authorities, departments of Government, Semi-Government or local authority.
- (h) To sign and verify all pleadings, memoranda or appeal, petitions and applications of all kinds and to engage




lawyers and other professionals and to take all such other necessary steps.

- (i) To borrow or raise any money that may be required by the TRUST upon such terms as may be deemed fit and to secure any moneys so borrowed by mortgage or charge of all or any part of the assets belonging to the TRUST.
- (j) To open and maintain accounts with Scheduled Bank and authorise operations of such accounts by any of the members of the Board of Trustees, jointly or severally and to draw, accept, endorse, discount and/or negotiate negotiable and quasi-negotiable instruments on behalf of the TRUST.
- (k) To pay out of the Trust Funds, Salaries, Wages, expenses for building maintenance, repairs and other expenses relating to the TRUST, its administration, management of its activities or its other affairs.
- (l) To appoint and/or dismiss staff, executives, officials, caretakers, attendants and other employees on such terms as the Board may think fit.
- (m) To appoint committees or sub-committees from among the members of the Board and/or along with others and assign duties and to frame with such Rules of business as the Board shall think fit, and to alter or vary the same from time to time, provided that such rules of business shall have be inconsistent with the terms of these presents. The Board shall be entitled to frame, constitute and regulate the procedures of such committees or sub-committees.

- (n) To undertake and carry on other work which may seem to the Board capable of with, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to help the promotion of the objects of the TRUST.
- (o) To decide all questions arising in the administration of TRUST and including all questions relating to the interpretation of these presents the administration of the any institution maintained by the TRUST or concerning any thing or any matter relating to, connected with or arising out of these presents or the operation thereof. The decision of the Board in all or any of the matters aforesaid shall be final.
- (p) The Board of Trustees shall conduct the activities of the TRUST in accordance with the stipulations set out herein. The Board of Trustees may delegate all or any of the powers vested in them to such person(s) for such period as they may deem fit and may at any time revoke, vary, alter & change such powers so delegated.
- (q) The TRUSTEES have power to frame such By-laws, subsidiary rules and regulations and shall have further power to add, delete or amend the same from time to time as may be necessary for the conduct of their business provided that the rules and regulations so framed and the amendments to the effect are not inconsistent with the objects of the TRUST and also the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, governing Charitable Trusts.
- (r) The persons enumerated in these presents shall be exercised by the Board strictly in conformity with the conditions laid down in the Income Tax Act, 1961 (43 of



1961) amended from time to time , so that the income of the Trust will be exempt from the Income Tax and the donors will get deduction in respect of their donations under section 80-G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 for each and every assessment year .


- (s) To do all other acts, deeds, matters and things which may be deemed necessary for carrying out the objects of this TRUST or its administration.
18. The official year of the TRUST shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year.
19. All provisions of this Deed or TRUST as well as any rules and regulations framed by the TRUSTEES shall be interpreted by the TRUSTEES and their decision in this regard shall be final and binding.
20. The President shall guide and direct the Secretary in regard to the administration of the TRUST. The Secretary shall be responsible to the President and the Board of Trustees in the absence of the Secretary, the President shall direct any other TRUSTEE to perform the duties of the Secretary.
21. The TRUSTEES shall meet as often as necessary to transact the business of the TRUST. There shall at all cost be two meetings of the TRUSTEES in a year. The Secretary shall convene the meetings of the TRUSTEES and prepare the agenda as to the items to be decided at the meeting, in consultation with the President. The Secretary shall be responsible to record the minutes of the meeting and to carry out the directions given or decision taken in such a meeting. He shall report to the President and the Board of Trustees the action taken by him in implementing the direction of the TRUSTEES.



22. (a) The decision of the Board of Trustees shall be taken on the basis of majority votes. In the case of equality of votes, the President in a meeting shall exercise a casting vote.
- (b) The quorum for a meeting, depending upon the number of TRUSTEES till then made, shall be 3 or less as the case may be. If there is no quorum, the meeting could be adjourned and the requirement of quorum shall not apply for such adjourned meeting.
- (c) It shall be opened to the Board of Trustees to adopt any resolution by circulating the same among the TRUSTEES, provided such a resolution is assented to by a majority of the TRUSTEES. All the Resolutions adopted by circulation shall be placed in the immediately next meeting of the Board of Trustees for recording the same.
23. Every TRUSTEE and the Secretary of the TRUST shall be indemnified from out of the Funds of the TRUST against all the loss or expenses incurred in the discharge of his duties, except such as has happened through his willful negligence or dishonesty.
24. All legal proceedings by or Against the TRUST shall be instituted in the name of the TRUST through its President.
25. The TRUSTEES shall have the power to alter or amend the provisions of this Deed of Trust only on having $\frac{3}{4}$ th majority vote of the Board of Trustees, provided that such alteration or amendment shall not be inconsistent with the object of this TRUST as well as the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, governing the Charitable Trusts; provided further that the amendments shall not be given effect to unless approved by the Commissioner of Income Tax.



26. It is hereby declared that the Honorary Secretary and the PRESIDENT shall have the power to execute any document required to be registered under the law and is further declared that such document shall be deemed to have been properly executed by the TRUST.
27. All Records, Minutes Books, Title Deeds, Securities, Account Books, Vouchers/ Papers and Documents relating to the TRUST shall remain in the custody of such person or persons and at such place or places as the TRUSTEES may from time to time determine.
28. IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that the TRUST shall be and remain Irrevocable for all but if the TRUSTEES so decide, then, with majority vote of $\frac{3}{4}$ th Board of the Trustees, they may hand over the corpus of the Trust Fund to any other TRUST or Institution or a Society, being a Society registered under the Society Registration Act, 1860 having identical or similar objects and purposed on such terms as the TRUSTEES may think to impose at the time of handing over the Trust Fund to intent and purpose that thereafter the Trust Fund shall be owned and managed by such Trust, Institution or Society BESIDES the above the TRUSTEES have also the power to dissolve the TRUST With the majority vote of $\frac{3}{4}$ th of Board of Trustees in such an event, the asset remaining on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the TRUSTEES, but the same shall be transferred to another charitable Trust whose objects are similar to those of this TRUST and which enjoys recognition under section 80-G of Indian Income Tax Act, 1961.

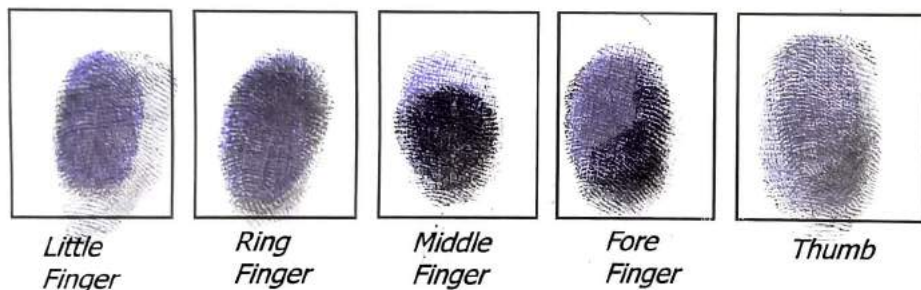

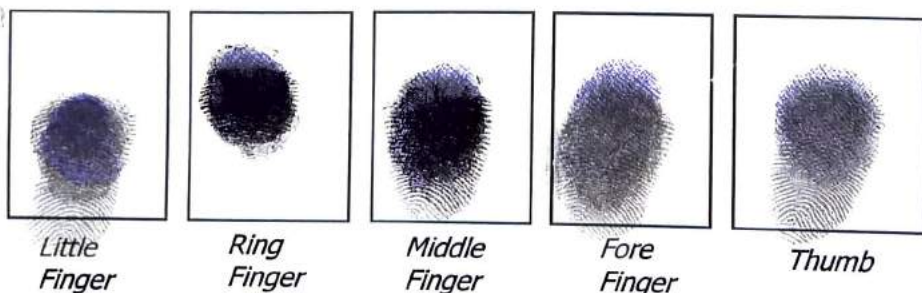
